
2018-2019 “Best UM Sports Team Athlete” and 2018-2019 “Outstanding UM Sports Team Athlete”

Application Method and Evaluation Guideline

Application Method

- Eligibility: UM Sports Team Members in the academic year of 2018-2019
With Semester GPA 2.0 or above in one of the last two Semesters
Recommended by respective Team Coach and Team Manager
(Max. 2 Nominees per Team)

- Application Procedure:
 - 1) Recommended UM Sports Team Members may download the related application form at (<http://sports.osa.um.edu.mo/>).

 - 2) After completing the application form with supported documents and photos:
 - a) Please email the softcopy of the documents (including applicant’s recent photo - for promotion) to the Office of Sports Affairs (OSA) : osa.development@um.edu.mo, **AND**
 - b) Submit the application form personally to OSA before the deadline (address: Room 1017, 1st Floor, N8 UM Sports Complex)
 - c) The application form must be printed, **hand-writing will not be accepted.**

- **Application Deadline: 19 April 2019 (Supporting documents and results of those competitions happens from 19 to 28 April 2019 must be submitted on or before 29 Apr 2019. Results of competitions finish after 28 April 2019 will be counted in the following academic year)**

Process of Award

- 1) All received application forms will be submitted to “Working Group for Award Scoring of Sports Awards” for evaluation and scoring calculation procedure. The Working Group will calculate the scores according to the Scoring Criteria below.

- 2) After the evaluation and scoring are completed, the awards will be presented to the awardees on **3 May 2019** at the “2018-2019 UM Sports Awards Presentation Ceremony”.

Award Method

- The two applicants with the highest scores will be the winners of “Best UM Sports Team Athlete” of the academic year. Each of the winners will be awarded a scholarship (sponsored by the Parry Group Investment and Development Company Limited or the Lisboa Holdings Limited) of MOP20,000, certificate and trophy.
- The 5 applicants who have the 3rd to 7th highest score will be the winners of “Outstanding UM Sports Team Athlete” of the year. Each of them will be awarded a scholarship (sponsored by the Parry Group Investment and Development Company Limited or the Lisboa Holdings Limited) of MOP10,000, certificate and trophy.

Scoring Criteria

The allocation of points is as follows:

(The competition results are considered from 1 May 2018 to 28 April 2019)

❖ Base on the applicants’ sports achievement

- **30 / 45 points** → **Representing UM** to achieve top 8 positions in All China University Championships (**only counting 1 best result**)
 - *Result of All China University Regional Championships are not counted in this category
 - *The points from the result of a relay/group event of individual sports should be divided by TWO)

According to the level of play for the athletes in the competition regulations, calculation of points is divided into two Tables (see below). If there is only one category, the Table of “General Students Category” will be adopted.

- If the competition was consisted of 3 or less participants, no marks will be counted
 - If the competition was consisted of 4 participants, only the 1st place points will be counted
 - If the competition was consisted of 5 participants, only the 1st place and 2nd place points will be counted
 - If the competition was consisted of 6 participants, only the points of the top 3 will be counted
 - If the competition was consisted of 7 participants, only the points of the top 4 will be counted
 - If the competition was consisted of 8 participants, only the points of the top 5 will be counted
 - If the competition was consisted of 9 participants, only the points of the top 6 will be counted
 - If the competition was consisted of 10 participants, only the points of the top 7 will be counted
 - If the competition was consisted of 11 participants, only the points of the top 8 will be counted
- Points will only be counted up to top 8 positions

➤ **20 / 30 points** → **Representing UM** to achieve top 8 positions in regional sports competitions such as All China University Regional Championships, the units of participants must come from 4 or more different regions (**only counting 1 best result**)
 *The points from the result of a relay/group event should be divided by TWO)

According to the level of play for the athletes in the competition regulations, calculation of points is divided into two Tables (see below). If there is only one category, the Table of “General Students Category” will be adopted.

- If the competition was consisted of 3 or less participants, no marks will be counted
- If the competition was consisted of 4 participants, only the 1st place points will be counted
- If the competition was consisted of 5 participants, only the 1st place and 2nd place points will be counted

- If the competition was consisted of 6 participants, only the points of the top 3 will be counted
 - If the competition was consisted of 7 participants, only the points of the top 4 will be counted
 - If the competition was consisted of 8 participants, only the points of the top 5 will be counted
 - If the competition was consisted of 9 participants, only the points of the top 6 will be counted
 - If the competition was consisted of 10 participants, only the points of the top 7 will be counted
 - If the competition was consisted of 11 participants, only the points of the top 8 will be counted
- Points will only be counted up to top 8 positions

- **15 points** → **Representing UM** to achieve top 3 positions in attended local Macau University Championships (**only counting 1 best result**)
- *The points from the result of a relay/group event should be divided by TWO
 - *Championships should be organized by the Macau Universitarian Sports' Association / Tertiary Education Services Office

Method of calculation of points (please refer to below table):

- If the competition was consisted of 2 or less participants, no marks will be counted
- If the competition was consisted of 3 participants, only the 1st place points will be counted
- If the competition was consisted of 4 participants, only the 1st place and 2nd place points will be counted
- If the competition was consisted of 5 participants, only the points of the top 3 will be counted
- Points will only be counted up to top 3 positions

- **12 points** → To achieve result in other Championships or Invitational Competitions (The number of participating units must be 4 or more, **only counting 1 best result**)
- *The points from the result of a relay/group event should be divided by TWO
 - *Competitions should be organized by the general sports associations or by authoritative bodies of the related sports, friendly matches are not counted

Method of calculation of points (please refer to **below table**):

- If the competition was consisted of 2 or less participants, no marks will be counted
- If the competition was consisted of 3 participants, only the 1st place points will be counted
- If the competition was consisted of 4 participants, only the 1st place and 2nd place points will be counted
- If the competition was consisted of 5 participants, only the points of the top 3 will be counted

Points will only be counted up to top 3 positions

- **10 points** → **Representing their own countries of origin** to achieve top 8 positions in regional sports competitions (the units of participants must come from 4 or more different regions, **only counting 1 best result**)

Method of calculation of points (please refer below table):

- If the competition was consisted of 3 or less participants, no marks will be counted
- If the competition was consisted of 4 participants, only the 1st place points will be counted
- If the competition was consisted of 5 participants, only the 1st place and 2nd place points will be counted
- If the competition was consisted of 6 participants, only the points of the top 3 will be counted
- If the competition was consisted of 7 participants, only the points of the top 4 will be counted
- If the competition was consisted of 8 participants, only the points of the top 5 will be counted
- If the competition was consisted of 9 participants, only the points of the top 6 will be counted
- If the competition was consisted of 10 participants, only the points of the top 7 will be counted
- If the competition was consisted of 11 participants, only the points of the top 8 will be counted

Points will only be counted up to top 8 positions

- ❖ **10 points** → **Base on the applicants' competition and training attendance** (please refer to below table)

- Evaluated by OSA according to the attendance record of UM Sports Team Members in the academic year

Points	Attendance
0	< 40%
4	40% ~ 59%
5	60% ~ 69%
7	70% ~ 79%
10	80% or above

5 points → Base on the applicants received sports related awards, attended training courses, seminars or large-scale activities which were related to sports

- Each received sports related award in the academic year will be counted as 1 points each;
- Each certificate from attending training courses, seminars or large-scale activities which are related to sports in the year academic will be counted as 1 points each;

If candidates have same scores after the above evaluation is completed, the “Working Group for Award Scoring of Sports Awards” will consider the below circumstances to determine the final scores of the candidates.

❖ 5 points → Base on the applicants’ academic achievements

- Base on GPA 3.7 or above = 5 points, score according to the academic achievement of the applicant.
(e.g. GPA=3, the score is $(3 / 3.7) \times 5 = 4.05$ points)

If the scores of the candidates are still the same, the below will be considered:

❖ 5 points → Base on the applicants’ participation in large-scale non-sports events organized by UM

- Each joined event will be counted as 1 point; certificates must be provided

Remark: “Working Group for Award Scoring of Sports Awards” reserves the right to make final decision of the scores.
