Application Method and Evaluation Guideline

Application Method

➤ Eligibility: Members of Macau Sports Team;

Recommendation by respective Team Coach and Manager for UM Sports

Team Members (Max. 1 Nominee per Team);

With Semester GPA 2.0 or above in one of the last two Semesters

➤ Application Procedure:

- 1) Athletes from Macau Sports Team or recommended UM Sports Team Members may download the related application form at (http://sports.osa.um.edu.mo/).
- 2) After completing the application form with supported documents and photos:
 - a) Please email the softcopy of the documents (including applicant's recent photo high resolution in JPG/PNG format for promotion) to the Office of Sports Affairs (OSA): osa.development@um.edu.mo, AND
 - b) Submit the application form personally to OSA before the deadline (address: Room 1017, 1st Floor, N8 UM Sports Complex)
 - c) The application form must be printed, hand-writing will not be accepted.
 - d) Certificates of competitions representing Macau Sports Team issued by related Sports Associations or Departments of Macau S.A.R. Government must be provided for valid scores calculation
- Application Deadline: 29 April 2020 (Supporting documents and results of those competitions happens from 9 to 26 April 2020 must be submitted on or before 27 Apr 2020. Results of competitions finish after 26 April 2020 will be counted in the following academic year)

Process of Award

- 1) All received application forms will be submitted to "Working Group for Award Scoring of Sports Awards" for evaluation and scoring calculation procedure. The Working Group will calculate the scores according to the Scoring Criteria below.
- 2) After the evaluation and scoring are completed, the awards will be presented to the awardees on **4 September 2020** at the "2019-2020 UM Sports Awards Presentation Ceremony".

Award Method

The 4 applicants with the highest scores will be the winners of "UM Outstanding Macau Athlete" of the academic year. Each of the winners will be awarded a scholarship (sponsored by the Parry Group Investment and Development Company Limited or Bank of China Macau Branch) of MOP20,000, certificate and trophy.

Scoring Criteria

The allocation of points is as follows:

(The competition results are considered from 29 April 2019 to 26 April 2020)

> 50 / 30 points → Awarded with Medal of Merit-Sport or Certificate of Merit-Sport by Macau SAR Government

Medal of Merit-Sport	50
Certificate of Merit-Sport	30

▶ 45/30/20 points → Representing Macau SAR to participate in regional sports competitions (the units of participants must come from 4 or more different regions), only counting 1 best result
*The points from the result of a relay/group event of individual sports should be divided by TWO)

- If the competition was consisted of 3 or less participants, no marks will be counted
- If the competition was consisted of 4 participants, only the 1st place points will be counted
- If the competition was consisted of 5 participants, only the 1st place and 2nd place points will be counted
- If the competition was consisted of 6 participants, only the points of the top 3 will be counted
- If the competition was consisted of 7 participants, only the points of the top 4 will be counted
- If the competition was consisted of 8 participants, only the points of the top 5 will be counted
- If the competition was consisted of 9 participants, only the points of the top 6 will be counted
- If the competition was consisted of 10 participants, only the points of the top 7 will be counted
- If the competition was consisted of 11 participants, only the points of the top 8 will be counted
- If top 8 cannot be achieved, students can still get points for participation of the related competition (see above table)

> 15 points → The Number of Competitions representing Macau SAR

Number of Competitions	Points

3 – 5	10
1 – 2	5

- > 5 points -> Base on the applicants received sports related awards, attended training courses, seminars or large-scale activities which were related to sports
 - Each received sports related award in the academic year will be counted as 1 points each;
 - ➤ Each certificate from attending training courses, seminars or large-scale activities which are related to sports in the year academic will be counted as 1 points each;

If candidates have same scores after the above evaluation is completed, the "Working Group for Award Scoring of Sports Awards" will consider the below circumstances to determine the final scores of the candidates.

➤ 5 points → Base on the applicants' academic achievements

➤ The score is according to the academic achievement of the applicants. Base on the scale of GPA, a score of GPA 4.0 is equal to 5 points; and for students in Law major, the top score of 20 is equal to 5 points as well.

e.g. GPA=3, the score is $(3/4.0) \times 5 = 3.75$ points;

For students in Law major, if their average score is 12, their will get: $(12/20) \times 5 = 3$ points.

If the scores of the candidates are still the same, the below will be considered:

- \triangleright 5 points \rightarrow Base on the applicants' participation in large-scale non-sports events organized by UM
 - ➤ Each joined event will be counted as 1 point; certificates must be provided
