- 1) **Competition Dates:** 14 Oct & 21 Oct, Friday
- 2) **Competition Time:** 18:00~21:00
- 3) **Competition Venue:** Tennis Court nos. 4-5
- 4) **Competition Information:**
 - a. Welcome Male or Female to form the team.
 - b. Format of Events (Single): All events shall be played on a knockout system.
The match will be 1 Set of 4 points (No Ad-Scoring). In case two teams got 3 points and Tie-Break set is going to win the match.
 - c. Format of Events (Double): All events shall be played on a knockout system.
The match will be 1 Set of 6 points (No Ad-Scoring). In case two teams got six points and Tie-Break set is going to win the match.
