Application Method and Evaluation Guideline**

**Application Method**

- Eligibility: Registered UM Sports Teams in the current academic year (i.e. the teams stated below)  
Recommended by respective Team Coach and Team Manager

- **Application Procedure:**

- 1) Recommended UM Sports Team Members can fill out the online application form via OSA webpage (<https://sports.osa.um.edu.mo/umsportsawards/>).
- 2) Submitting the application form with supported documents and photos:
  - a) Submit the online application before the deadline
  - b) All supplementary documents (certificates, photos etc.) must be submitted via the online application system or email to **osa.development@um.edu.mo**

- **Application Deadline: 30 April 2021**

**(Supporting documents must be submitted on or before 4 May 2021. Results of competitions finish after 30 April 2021 will be counted in the following academic year)**

## Process of Award

- 1) All received application forms will be submitted to “Working Group for Award Scoring of Sports Awards” for evaluation and scoring calculation procedure. The Working Group will calculate the score according to the Scoring Criteria below.
- 2) After the evaluation and scoring are completed, the awards will be presented to the awardees on **18 May 2021** at the “2020-2021 UM Sports Awards Presentation Ceremony”.

## Award Method

- The team with the highest score will be the winner of “Best UM Sports Team – Team Sports” of the academic year. The team will be awarded a scholarship (sponsored by the Parry Group Investment and Development Company Limited) of MOP20,000 and a certificate.
- The team with the highest score will be the winner of “Best UM Sports Team – Individual Sports” of the academic year. The team will be awarded a scholarship (sponsored by the Parry Group Investment and Development Company Limited) of MOP20,000 and a certificate.

## Scoring Criteria

The allocation of points is as follows:

**(The competition results are considered from 27 April 2020 to 30 April 2021)**

### ❖ **Base on the applied team’s sports achievement**

- **30 / 45 points** → **Representing UM** to achieve top 8 positions in All China University Championships (**only counting 1 best result**)  
\*Results of All China University Regional Championships are not counted in this category

According to the level of play for the athletes in the competition regulations, calculation of points is divided into two Tables (see below). If there is only one category, the Table of “General Students Category” will be adopted.

- If the competition was consisted of 3 or lower teams, no points will be counted
- If the competition was consisted of 4 teams, only the points of 1<sup>st</sup> place will be counted
- If the competition was consisted of 5 teams, only the points of 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> place will be counted
- If the competition was consisted of 6 teams, only the points of the top 3 will be counted
- If the competition was consisted of 7 teams, only the points of the top 4 will be counted
- If the competition was consisted of 8 teams, only the points of the top 5 will be counted

- If the competition was consisted of 9 teams, only the points of the top 6 will be counted
- If the competition was consisted of 10 teams, only the points of the top 7 will be counted
- If the competition was consisted of 11 teams, only the points of the top 8 will be counted
- Points will only be counted up to top 8 positions

➤ **20 / 30 points** → **Representing UM** to achieve top 8 positions in regional sports competitions such as All China University Regional Championships, the units of participants must come from 4 or more different regions.

Competitions should be organized by the general sports associations or by authoritative bodies of the related sports (**only counting 1 best result**)

According to the level of play for the athletes in the competition regulations, calculation of points is divided into two Tables (see below). If there is only one category, the Table of “General Students Category” will be adopted.

- If the competition was consisted of 3 or less participants, no marks will be counted
- If the competition was consisted of 4 participants, only the 1<sup>st</sup> place points will be counted
- If the competition was consisted of 5 participants, only the 1<sup>st</sup> place and 2<sup>nd</sup> place points will be counted

- **15 points** → **Representing UM** to achieve top 3 positions in local Macau University Championships (**only counting 1 best result**)  
 \*Championships should be organized by the Macau Universitarian Sports' Association / Tertiary Education Services Office

Method of calculation of points (please refer to below table):

- If the competition was consisted of 2 or less participants, no marks will be counted
- If the competition was consisted of 3 participants, only the 1<sup>st</sup> place points will be counted
- If the competition was consisted of 4 participants, only the 1<sup>st</sup> place and 2<sup>nd</sup> place points will be counted
- If the competition was consisted of 5 participants, only the points of the top 3 will be counted
- Points will only be counted up to top 3 positions

- **12 points** → **Representing UM** to achieve result in other Championships or Invitational Competitions (The number of participating units must be 4 or more, **only counting 1 best result**)  
 \*Competitions should be organized by the general sports associations or by authoritative bodies of the related sports, friendly matches are not counted

Method of calculation of points (please refer to **below table**):

- If the competition was consisted of 2 or less participants, no marks will be counted
- If the competition was consisted of 3 participants, only the 1<sup>st</sup> place points will be counted
- If the competition was consisted of 4 participants, only the 1<sup>st</sup> place and 2<sup>nd</sup> place points will be counted
- If the competition was consisted of 5 participants, only the points of the top 3 will be counted

❖ **20 points** → **Base on the team's competition and training attendance**

➤ Evaluated by OSA according to the attendance record of the team in the academic year

Points	Attendance
0	< 40%
8	40% ~ 59%
10	60% ~ 69%
14	70% ~ 79%
16	80% ~ 89%
20	80% or above

❖ **5 points** → **Base on received sports related awards, attended training courses, seminars or large-scale activities by the members of applied team which were related to sports**

- Each received sports related award in the academic year will be counted as 1 points each;
- Each certificate from attending training courses, seminars or large-scale activities which are related to sports in the academic year will be counted as 1 points each;

If candidates have same scores after the above evaluation is completed, the “Working Group for Award Scoring of Sports Awards” will consider the below circumstances to determine the final scores of the candidates.

❖ **5 points** → **Base on the applicants' participation in large-scale non-sports events organized by UM**

- Each joined event will be counted as 1 point; certificates must be provided

*# Remark: The Working Group for Award Scoring may adjust the above scoring criteria according to actual circumstances.*
