Application Method and Evaluation Guideline

Application Method

Eligibility: Registered UM Sports Team Members in the current academic year With Semester GPA 2.0 or above in one of the last two Semesters Recommended by respective Team Coach and Team Manager (Max. 2 Nominees per Team)

> Application Procedure:

- Recommended UM Sports Team Members can fill out the online application form via OSA webpage (<u>https://sports.osa.um.edu.mo/umsportsawards/</u>).
- 2) Submitting the application form with supported documents and photos:
 - a) Submit the online application before the deadline
 - b) All supplementary documents (certificates, photos etc.) must be submitted via the online application system or email to **osa.scholarship@um.edu.mo**

Application Deadline: 23 April 2025

(Supporting documents must be submitted on or before 30 April 2025. Results of competitions finish after 30 April 2025 will be counted in the following academic year)

Process of Award

- 1) All received application forms will be submitted to "Working Group for Award Scoring of Sports Awards" for evaluation and scoring calculation procedure. The Working Group will calculate the scores according to the Scoring Criteria below.
- After the evaluation and scoring are completed, the awards will be presented to the awardees on 30 April 2025 at the "UM Sports Awards Presentation Ceremony".

Award Method

Winners will receive scholarship and certificate (Details will be announced later)

Scoring Criteria

The allocation of points is as follows:

(The competition results are considered from 1 May 2024 to 30 April 2025)

* Base on the applicants' sports achievement

> 30 / 45 points →
Representing UM to achieve top 8 positions in All China University Championships (only counting 1 best result)
*Results of All China University Regional Championships are not counted in this category
*The points from the result of a relay/group event of individual sports should be divided by TWO (doubles events of Badminton, Squash, Table Tennis and Tennis are excluded)

According to the level of play for the athletes in the competition regulations, calculation of points is divided into two Tables (see below). If there is only one category, the Table of "General Students Category" will be adopted.

▶ 20 / 30 points → Representing UM to achieve top 8 positions in regional sports competitions such as All China University Regional Championships, the units of participants must come from 4 or more different regions (only counting 1 best result) Competitions should be organized by the general sports associations or by authoritative bodies of the related sports. *The points from the result of a relay/group event should be divided by TWO

(doubles events of Badminton, Squash, Table Tennis and Tennis are excluded)

According to the level of play for the athletes in the competition regulations, calculation of points is divided into two Tables (see below). If there is only one category, the Table of "General Students Category" will be adopted.

▶ 15 points → Representing UM to achieve top 3 positions in attended local Macau University Championships (only counting 1 best result) *The points from the result of a relay/group event should be divided by TWO

(doubles events of Badminton, Squash, Table Tennis and Tennis are excluded)

*Championships should be organized by the Macau Universitarian Sports' Association / Education and Youth Development Bureau

Method of calculation of points (please refer to below table):

- If the competition was consisted of 2 or less participants, no marks will be counted
- If the competition was consisted of 3 participants, only the 1st place points will be counted
- If the competition was consisted of 4 participants, only the 1st place and 2nd place points will be counted
- If the competition was consisted of 5 participants, only the points of the top 3 will be counted
- Points will only be counted up to top 3 positions

▶ 12 points → To achieve top 3 positions in other Championships or Invitational Competitions (The number of participating units must be 4 or more, only counting 1 best result)
*The points from the result of a relay/group event should be divided by TWO (doubles events of Badminton, Squash, Table Tennis and Tennis are excluded)
*Competitions should be organized by the general sports associations or by authoritative bodies of the related sports, friendly matches are not counted

Method of calculation of points (please refer to **below table**):

- If the competition was consisted of 2 or less participants, no marks will be counted
- If the competition was consisted of 3 participants, only the 1st place points will be counted
- If the competition was consisted of 4 participants, only the 1st place and 2nd place points will be counted
- If the competition was consisted of 5 participants, only the points of the top 3 will be counted

Points will only be counted up to top 3 positions

➤ 10 points → Representing their own countries of origin to achieve top 8 positions in regional sports competitions (the units of participants must come from 4 or more different regions. Competitions should be organized by the general sports associations or by authoritative bodies of the related sports only counting 1 best result)

Method of calculation of points (please refer below table):

- If the competition was consisted of 3 or less participants, no marks will be counted
- If the competition was consisted of 4 participants, only the 1st place points will be counted
- If the competition was consisted of 5 participants, only the 1st place and 2nd place points will be counted
- If the competition was consisted of 6 participants, only the points of the top 3 will be counted
- If the competition was consisted of 7 participants, only the points of the top 4 will be counted
- If the competition was consisted of 8 participants, only the points of the top 5 will be counted
- If the competition was consisted of 9 participants, only the points of the top 6 will be counted
- If the competition was consisted of 10 participants, only the points of the top 7 will be counted
- If the competition was consisted of 11 participants, only the points of the top 8 will be counted

> Evaluated by OSA according to the attendance record of UM Sports Team Members in the academic year

5 points \rightarrow Base on the applicants received sports related awards, attended training courses, seminars or large-scale activities which were related to sports

> Each received sports related award in the academic year will be counted as 1 points each;

- Each certificate from attending training courses, seminars or large-scale activities which are related to sports in the year academic will be counted as 1 points each;
- \succ The maximum score for this section is 5.

If candidates have same scores after the above evaluation is completed, the "Working Group for Award Scoring of Sports Awards" will consider the below circumstances to determine the final scores of the candidates.

The score is according to the academic achievement of the applicants. Base on the scale of GPA, a score of GPA 4.0 is equal to 5 points; and for students in Law major, the top score of 20 is equal to 5 points as well.

e.g. GPA=3, the score is $(3 / 4.0) \times 5 = 3.75$ points;

For students in Law major, if their average score is 12, their will get: $(12 / 20) \times 5 = 3$ points.

If the scores of the candidates are still the same, the below will be considered:

✤ 5 points → Base on the applicants' participation in large-scale non-sports events organized by UM

> Each joined event will be counted as 1 point; certificates must be provided
